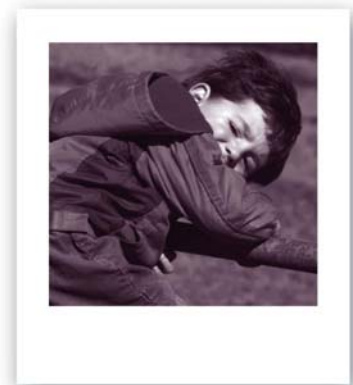
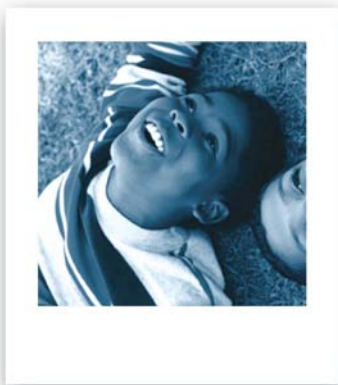

Quarterly Performance Monitoring Report

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1. PURPOSE

1.1 INTRODUCTION

In its 2002 report the Improving the Effectiveness of the Youth Justice System Working Group established a set of national standards for Scotland's youth justice services. The delivery challenge for each multi-disciplinary youth justice team in every Local Authority is to implement these standards and to achieve the national target of reducing the number of Persistent Offenders by 10% by 2006. In June 2006, Justice Minister Cathy Jamieson announced at the annual Youth Justice Conference that the target for 2008 would stand at a further 10% reduction.

To assist Local Authorities in achieving this target and implement the full range of national standards, a baseline report was produced and published in August 04. It set out performance in the financial year 2003/04 against a number of key indicators. In consultation with Ministers, the Scottish Executive, COSLA and ACPOS, the Scottish Children's Reporters Administration (SCRA) committed to produce and publish a series of Quarterly Performance Monitoring Reports to enable monitoring of these indicators, namely:

Overall

1. The total number of young people referred to SCRA on offence grounds during the period.
2. The total number of offence-based referrals received by SCRA during the period being reported.

Persistent Offenders

3. The number of young people who triggered the national Persistent Offender definition during the period being reported.
4. The number of offence based referrals received by SCRA for children who triggered the national Persistent Offender definition during the period being reported.

Timeliness

5. Key Time Interval Standards, showing speed of working across key agencies:
 - i. Time Interval Standard 1 – Speed of Submission of police reports to SCRA
 - ii. Time Interval Standard 3 – Timely submission of social work reports to SCRA
 - iii. Time Interval Standard 4 – Speed of Reporter decision making
6. Average overall time taken between the receipt of an offence-based referral by SCRA and a decision being reached by a Children's Hearing.

The data produced for this report has been displayed alongside the comparative quarter for the previous year and will build throughout the year to show all quarters for the current year and the comparator for the quarter in the reporting period of previous year.

2. DESCRIPTION OF DATA TABLES

2.1 OVERALL NUMBERS OF OFFENCE BASED REFERRALS

Table 1. shows for each Local Youth Justice Area

- Total numbers for All Children (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Number of children referred to SCRA on offence grounds
 - Number of offence-based referrals received by SCRA
- Total numbers for children who triggered the national Persistent Offender definition in the period (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Number of Persistent Offenders referred to SCRA on offence grounds
 - Number of offence-based Persistent Offender referrals
- Child population (ages 8-16)

Table 2. shows a number of factors that can be calculated for each Local Youth Justice Area by examining the number of referrals and the number of Persistent Offenders:

- All Children (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Overall offence-based referrals as a percentage of national total of offence-based referrals
 - Average offence based referrals per child
 - Children referred as %age of population
- Persistent Offenders (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - New Persistent Offender offence based referrals as a proportion of the national total.
 - Average offence-based referrals per Persistent Offender
 - Persistent offenders as % of population
 - %age local referrals attributed to persistent offenders

2.2 'AS AT' PERSISTENT OFFENDER COUNT

- Qualifying Persistent Offenders (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Number of persistent offenders referred to SCRA as at end of quarter including new and re-qualified
 - % of Children re-qualified as persistent offenders from 03-04 to 04-05 and from 04-05 to 05-06

2.3 RECEIPT OF OFFENCE-BASED REFERRAL TO HEARING DECISION QUARTERLY DATA

Table 4. shows for each Local Youth Justice Area:

- All Children (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Number of offence-based referrals with Hearing decisions in the period
 - Average time to offence-based Hearing Decision from receipt of an offence-based referral by SCRA
- Persistent Offenders* (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Number of offence-based referrals with Hearing decisions made in the period for the total number of children who meet the definition of a Persistent Offender
 - Average time to offence-based Hearing Decision from receipt of an offence-based referral by SCRA

* Persistent Offender relates to all hearing decisions made in the period for children meeting the definition of a Persistent Offender i.e. any newly flagged Persistent Offenders plus any previously flagged that a decision had been made for in the period

2.4 TIME INTERVAL STANDARD 1

Target - Police will deliver 80% of offence based referral reports to SCRA within 14 calendar days of the date of caution/charge.

- Total number of offence-based referrals submitted to SCRA
- Total number of offence-based referrals submitted to SCRA within the national standard

2.5 TIME INTERVAL STANDARD 3

Target – 75% of Social Work Reports will be submitted to the Reporter within 20 working days of the date of request.

 - Number of social work reports received by SCRA
 - Average number of working days to submission
 - Percentage submitted within national standard
- Persistent Offenders* (Quarter 1 05-06 and Quarter 1 06-07)
 - Number of social work reports received by SCRA for the total number of children who meet the definition of a Persistent Offender
 - Average number of days to submission
 - Percentage submitted within national standard

* Persistent Offender relates to all decisions made in the period for children meeting the definition of a Persistent Offender i.e. any newly flagged Persistent Offenders plus any previously flagged that a decision had been made for in the period

2.6 TIME INTERVAL STANDARD 4

Target - The Reporter will make a decision about 60% of referrals within 50 working days of receipt.

 - Number of offence-based decisions made by the Reporter
 - Average number of days to offence-based decision

 - Number of Persistent Offender offence-based decisions made by the Reporter for the total number of children who meet the definition of a Persistent Offender – this includes children previously flagged as a Persistent and those children who have triggered the national definition during the period
 - Average number of days to offence-based decision
 - Percentage of decisions within national standard

3. DATA ANALYSIS

Overall Referrals

- There were 6543 children referred on offence grounds in Quarter 1 06-07, this is down 6% compared to Quarter 1 of previous year.
- The number of referrals received in the quarter was down 3.5% on comparative quarter in previous year, this increased the ratio of referrals per child to 1.51
- The number of new persistent offenders was 218 in Quarter 1 06-07, this is an increase of 34 on the number qualified in the comparative quarter in previous year.
- The new persistent offenders accounted for 918 offence-based referrals received by the Reporter at a rate of 4.21 referrals per child
- At the end of the quarter, 654 children had qualified as persistent offenders. This was an increase of 90 young people on the 05-06 Quarter 1 period. *(The 'As-at' figure of persistent offenders represents the number of children that qualified by the end of the quarter, this includes children that have previously qualified and have fully re-qualified again in 06-07 as well as children that have triggered the definition for the first time.)*
- By the end of Quarter 1 in 06-07, 29% of the persistent offenders from the previous year had re-qualified, this is in line with rate seen in 05-06.

Receipt to Hearing Decision

- The average number of days from receipt of offence based referral to Hearing decision was 68 days for All Children group in Quarter 1, a continuation of the improvements seen toward the end of previous year and a 6 day improvement compared to Quarter 1 05-06.
- Improvement was also seen in the average days to Hearing decision for the persistent offender group in Quarter 1 with an average of 66 days, a four day improvement on Quarter 1 05-06.

Time Interval Standard 1 - Police Report Submission

- There was a 16% decrease in the number of Police reports submitted to the Reporter compared to Quarter 1 05-06
- 87% of Police reports were submitted within the standard compared to 78% in previous year.
- Time Intervals Standard 1 was attained by 6 forces,

Time Interval Standard 3 - Social Work Report Submission

- It took an average on 34 days for submission of reports for All Children – an improvement of 4 days from Quarter 1 in the previous year.
- 40% of Social Work Reports were received within 20 days, this is an improvement on 35% seen in Quarter 1 05-06

- Reports for persistent offenders took an average of 31 days to submission – an improvement of 3 days from Quarter 1 in previous year.
- 38% of Social Work reports for persistent offenders were submitted within 20 days

Time Interval Standard 4 - Reporter Decisions

- The average number of days to reporter decision for Quarter 1 was 43 days. 71% of decisions were made within timescales for All Children.
- 75% of reporter decisions for new persistent offenders were made within timescales, with the average number of days to decision being 35
