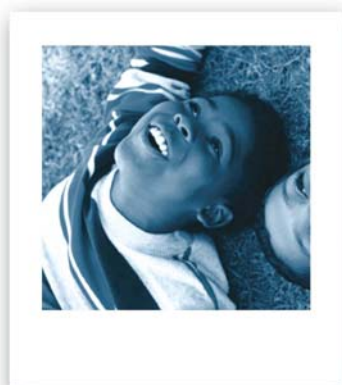

## Quarterly Performance Monitoring Report

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## **1. PURPOSE**

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### **1.1 INTRODUCTION**

In its 2002 report, the Improving the Effectiveness of the Youth Justice System Working Group established a set of national standards for Scotland's youth justice services. The delivery challenge for each multi-disciplinary youth justice team in every Local Authority was to implement these standards and to achieve the national target of reducing the number of Persistent Young Offenders<sup>1</sup> by 10% by 2006. In June 2006, Justice Minister Cathy Jamieson announced at the annual Youth Justice Conference, that the target for 2008 would stand at a further 10% reduction.

To assist Local Authorities in achieving this target and implementing the full range of national standards, a baseline report was produced and published in August 2004. It set out performance in the financial year 2003/04 against a number of key indicators. In consultation with Ministers, the Scottish Executive, the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities (COSLA) and the Association of Chief Police Officers in Scotland (ACPOS), the Scottish Children's Reporters Administration (SCRA) committed to produce and publish a series of Quarterly Performance Monitoring Reports to enable monitoring of these indicators.

These Quarterly Performance Monitoring Reports and the Scottish Youth Justice Annual Performance Report provide information on the numbers of children referred to the Children's Reporter on offence grounds, and how their cases were processed within the Children's Hearings System. The reports also provide information on the numbers of Persistent Young Offenders. The Children's Hearings System deals with children referred on offence grounds and children referred on care and protection grounds. 53,883 children were referred to the Reporter in 2005/06 -17,624 on offence grounds. 8% of those referred on offence grounds were identified as Persistent Young Offenders.

### **1.2 KEY INDICATORS**

The indicators covered in these quarterly and annual performance monitoring reports are as follows:

#### **Overall**

1. The total number of children and young people referred to the Children's Reporter on offence grounds during the period.
2. The total number of offence-based referrals received by the Children's Reporter during the period being reported.

#### **Persistent Young Offenders**

3. The number of children and young people who triggered the national Persistent Young Offender definition during the period being reported.

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<sup>1</sup> A Persistent Young Offender in the context of the Children's Hearings System is defined as a child or young person with five offending episodes within a six month period, where an offending episode is equal to a referral to the Children's Reporter under the Children (Scotland) Act 1995 section 52(2)(i).

4. The number of offence based referrals received by the Reporter for children and young people who triggered the national Persistent Young Offender definition during the period being reported.

**Timeliness**

5. Key Time Interval Standards, showing speed of working across key agencies:
  - i. Time Interval Standard 1 – Speed of submission of police reports to the Reporter
  - ii. Time Interval Standard 3 – Timely submission of social work reports to the Reporter
  - iii. Time Interval Standard 4 – Speed of Reporter decision making
6. Average overall time taken between the receipt of an offence-based referral by the Children's Reporter and a decision being reached by a Children's Hearing.

The data produced for this report has been displayed alongside the comparative quarter for the previous year and will build throughout the year to show all quarters for the current year and the comparator for the quarter in the reporting period of the previous year with the exception of quarter 4 which is replaced by the annual report

## **2. DESCRIPTION OF DATA TABLES**

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### **2.1 OVERALL NUMBERS OF OFFENCE-BASED REFERRALS**

- Total numbers for All Children (Quarter 3 05-06, Quarter 1 06-07, Quarter 2 06-07, and Quarter 3 06-07)

  - Number of Persistent Young Offenders referred to the Reporter on offence grounds
  - Number of offence-based Persistent Young Offender referrals to the Reporter
- Child population (ages 8-16)\*

## 2.4 TIME INTERVAL STANDARD 1

Target - Police will deliver 80% of offence-based referral reports to the Reporter within 14 calendar days of the date of caution/charge.

- Total number of offence-based referrals submitted to the Reporter

## 2.5 TIME INTERVAL STANDARD 3

Target – 75% of Social Work Reports will be submitted to the Reporter within 20 working days of the date of request.

## 2.6 TIME INTERVAL STANDARD 4

Target - The Reporter will make a decision about 60% of referrals within 50 working days of receipt.

### 3. DATA ANALYSIS

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#### Overall Offence Referrals

- There were 5892 children and young people referred to the Reporter on offence grounds in Quarter 3 06-07, this was a very slight increase from Quarter 2 06-07. There were 300 fewer children referred than the comparative quarter of the previous year.
- There were 8661 offence referrals received in the quarter, down 895 on the same quarter in 05-06. The average number of offence referrals per child was 1.47 in Quarter 3 06-07.
- The number of new Persistent Young Offenders qualifying in Quarter 3 06-07 was 182, this was 36 less than the number qualified in the comparative quarter in previous year and in each of the first two quarters of 06-07.
- The number of Persistent Young Offenders that re-qualified between Quarter 2 06-07 and Quarter 3 06-07 was also less than the comparative quarters of 05-06.
- The new Persistent Young Offenders accounted for 662 offence-based referrals received by the Reporter at a rate of 3.64 referrals per child
- At the end of the quarter, 1177\* children and young people had qualified as Persistent Young Offenders. This was 72 more young people than in the comparative 05-06 Quarter 3 period. This 72 however, is narrower than the difference of 90 seen at the end of the Quarter 1 06-07 compared with Quarter 1 05-06. (*\*This 'As-at' figure of Persistent Young Offenders represents the number of children that qualified by the end of the quarter, this includes children that have previously qualified and have fully re-qualified again in 06-07 as well as children that have triggered the definition for the first time.*)
- By the end of Quarter 3 in 06-07, 36.9% of the Persistent Young Offenders from the previous year had re-qualified, in comparison to 36.3% by end of Quarter 3 in 05-06.

### **Receipt to Hearing Decision**

- The average number of days from receipt of offence-based referral by the Reporter to Hearing decision was 71 working days for all children referred on offence grounds in Quarter 3 this was a 6 day improvement on Quarter 2 06-07.
- There was also an increase in performance for the average days to Hearing decision for the Persistent Young Offender group in Quarter 3, with an average of 69 days compared to 77 in the previous quarter in 06-07.

### **Time Interval Standard 1 - Police Report Submission**

- There was a 26.1% decrease in the number of Police reports submitted to the Reporter from Quarter 2 06-07 and 26.8% decrease from comparative quarter in previous year.
- 83.8% of Police reports were submitted within the standard compared to 81.2% in previous year.
- Time Intervals Standard 1 was attained by 6 out the 8 Police forces.

### **Time Interval Standard 3 - Social Work Report Submission**

- It took an average of 33 working days for submission of social work reports to the Reporter for all children referred on offence grounds – an additional 3 days compared to quarter 2 in 06-07.
- 47% of Social Work Reports were received by the Reporter within 20 working days showing no change from the previous quarter in 06-07.
- Reports for Persistent Young Offenders took an average of 30 working days to submission to the Reporter – an additional day from Quarter 3 in the previous year and an additional 4 days from Quarter 2 in 06-07.
- 53% of Social Work reports for Persistent Young Offenders were submitted to the Reporter within 20 working days, this is an improvement in performance from that seen in the previous quarter in 06-07.

### **Time Interval Standard 4 - Reporter Decisions**

- The average number of days to Reporter decision for Quarter 3 07-07 was 42 days, an improvement of 3 days on Quarter 3 05-06 and an improvement of 1 day from the previous quarter in 06-07.
- 72% of Reporter decisions for newly qualified Persistent Young Offenders were made within the timescales, with the average number of days to decision being 37 working days.
