Pre-Hearing visits

In 2015, as part of SCRA's commitment to improving children, young people and families' experience of attending Children's Hearings, SCRA created a [guide](#) for Social Workers to ensure that they are aware of the variety of information mediums available to improve children, young people and families' understanding of, and participation in, a Children's Hearing.

SCRA now offers 'Pre-Hearing visits' to any child or young person who requests this. They will be shown around the Hearings centre by a Reporter or member of staff and will be provided with an information pack to familiarise themselves with what to expect.

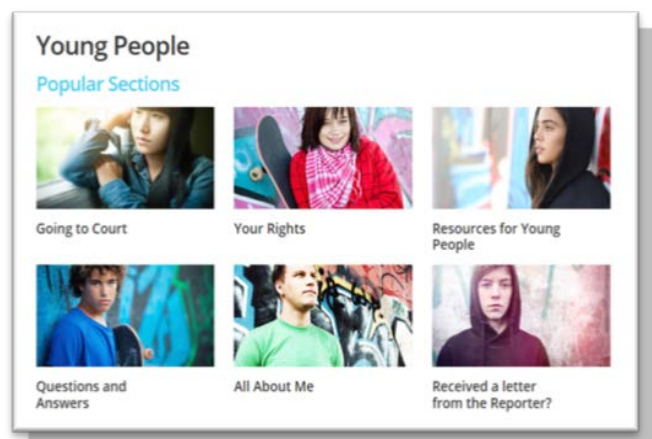
