
Welcome to your Children's Hearing self-care scrapbook created by young people at **Our Hearings**, **Our Voice** for children and young people.

# YOUR RIGHTS BEFORE YOUR HEARING



Rights are things that have to happen. Did you know you have lots of rights in your Hearing?

In your Hearing, you have the right to:

- Give your views to the Panel Members. They will listen to your views and it will help them make a decision.
- Give information that you want the Hearing to know about.
- Be given all the information that the Hearing has, if you can understand it.
- Bring a trusted person with you to help you discuss things in your Hearing.
- Bring a lawyer (solicitor).
- Have the number of people attending the Hearing (at the same time) to be kept to as few as possible.






At Our Hearings, Our Voice, ducks are our mascot. We would love to see what your duck looks like. Turn over the page to have a go.
